WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Illinois issued Order M.R. 18368 effective January 1, 2013, approving "Electronic Filing Standards and Principles" to maintain uniformity of electronic filing practices and procedures throughout the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, M.R. 18368 directs that local rules or administrative orders be adopted by circuits or counties within circuits to implement an e-filing program; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 2015- 30 entered May 4, 2015, which established the standards and principles for e-filing in Clinton County of the Fourth Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, Clinton County has added additional case categories for e-filing and now allows for the filing of an Application to Sue or Defend as an Indigent Person.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT the attached "Electronic Filing Standards Implementing E-Filing Program – Fourth Judicial Circuit – Clinton County", which have been amended to include adoption and mental health cases categories and the ability to file an Application to Sue or Defend as an Indigent Person, is hereby adopted and effective the date written below.
